Inquiry-based learning...

Young children love to ask questions. It's one of the ways in which they make sense of the world and their place in it. Questions are also a powerful tool for educators to promote children's thinking and learning. When children are able to pose questions and investigate answers, they feel in charge of their own learning. Mansfield Kindergarten uses inquirybased approaches to learning so that we harness this spirit of investigation. Creating an interesting, engaging and meaningful curriculum we use children's interests and questions as a starting point for effective learning. For young children, the most effective learning happens when they have repeated opportunities to use materials and resources to develop understandings of new concepts and ideas. One of the best aspects of inquirybased approaches is that they often lead to extended, ongoing investigations. When children reflect on what they have done previously, plan for what they are going to do in the future, and have the opportunity to discuss, rethink and change their plans as they go, their learning and thinking becomes far more complex.
