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What is the Early Years Learning Framework?

The EYLF has a strong focus on play-based learning, as well as communication and language (including early literacy and numeracy) and social and emotional development.

The EYLF is built around three interlinked ideas about children's learning and development.

- **Belonging** is already part of a child's life, through relationships within a family, but it also describes how a child should feel in an early childhood education and care setting.
- **Being** reflects the immediacy, spontaneity and intensity of children's learning experiences, the 'here and now' of children's lives.
- **Becoming** refers to the change and growth that occurs for young children in the early years; it emphasizes learning and experiences that will support children to be active citizens into the future (DEEWR, 2009, p 5)
